

As per the seismotectonic atlas published by Geological Survey of India and B.I.S code 1893, the entire North Bengal falls in zone-IV and few locations are also prone to near field vibration due to some Neo-tectonic fault line.

Huge rainfall in the range of 3500-4500 mm(Average annual), Wild life Sanctuary, Forest, Hills, Tea and Tourism Industry are yet to be exploited.


The workshop held on 24 January 2014, at college building.

Bridging the Gap

Background:

The purpose of the seminar:

Although India receives 350,000 engineers and 2.5 million university graduates annually as new workforce, at any given time, about five million graduates remain unemployed. A survey done by McKinsey Global Institute demonstrates that multinationals find only 25% of Indian engineers job ready.

The industry, on the other hand, has had its share of challenges in getting their requirements filled. Not only have they degraded their hiring standards in order to be fully staffed, they have established training programs to make new entrants productive. But this situation is untenable because it hampers productivity and there is not a viable model for employers to 'manufacture' their own employees.

While we cannot predict the kind of jobs that would be available in the future, there is no stopping all job aspirants, industry and the education system from preparing for these jobs. 


COLLABORATION WITH CENTRE FOR INNOVATION (CFI)




